An invitation has been offered to Puente to speak at the September 30 worship service. This would be followed by a potluck luncheon. The Peace-Making Offering, \$287.75 was donated to the Fernando Rivera Middle School, which be used in their peace peer counseling classes. From our Pentecostal offering, a donation of \$218 was given to Ecumenical House Ministry at San Francisco State and presented to Rev. Hannah Cornthwaite, our guest preacher, during worship on May 27. A donation of \$250 will be made to Puente del Sur for the purchase of backpacks and school supplies for the fall term of the school year. Also, we will have Sock It to Me Sundays, August 12, 19 and 26, and the socks will be given to the Puente speaker later in September.
