From the Pastor

This has been a difficult week for many of us, especially women, as the Supreme Court overturned Roe v Wade, which reverses nearly 50 years of legal precedent, and takes away a woman's right to make decisions for her own body and health care.

For over 30 years, the PCUSA has been very clear about a woman's right to make her own reproductive health choices, and vows to continue to fight for the rights of all women.

The Stated Clerk of the PCUSA Rev. Dr. J Herbert Nelson, II states, "We still have a lot to say about this issue from the impact on people of color, health and safety, as well as religious freedom."

I have had many conversations with friends this past week. There is great fear and anxiety in our midst that the most recent ruling by the Supreme Court is just the beginning of denying people their rights.

In 2015, two of my gay friends called me and said they were coming to California so I could perform their wedding vows. This week - end they told me they were considering moving out of our country because they don't like living in a

country where your rights will be at the mercy of politicians every few years. They no longer see a path that keeps that from happening.

We are people of HOPE. Our faith gives us hope that life can and will change when we put our hearts, hands, feet and voice to work. We don't give up! We stand in solidarity with our siblings when they are struggling or being discriminated against.

May God bless our congregation as we go forward in our life together seeking to live out our call of justice and peace.

Let us be in prayer for our country, our leaders, and especially for those whose lives will be deeply affected by these decisions.
