Dear Broadmoor Community,

The Meaning of Maundy Thursday

Maundy Thursday commemorates the night that Jesus shared his last (Passover) supper with his disciples. Before the supper, he washed his disciples' feet and commanded them to "love one another as I have loved you." During the supper, he gave new meaning to the bread (as signifying his body) and the cup (as signifying his blood) and commanded his followers to perpetuate this meal as a remembrance of his loving, saving sacrifice. In case you were wondering, the word "maundy" is from the Latin word "maundanum" which means "commandment;" a reference to the commandments of love and sacrament given by Jesus on that night before Good Friday and the cross.
