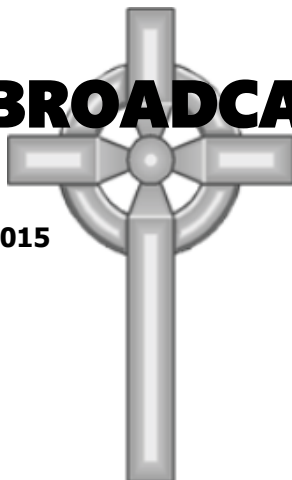

PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN SPRING EVENT

A special thank you to all the people who came and helped out and then participated in our Beach Party. We had a terrific time and fabulous fun. I hope everyone got some treasure. I was asked for the recipe for the Strawberry-Thyme Lemonade that I made. I made this recipe in my summer school cooking class last year. The kids liked it too.

STRAWBERRY-THYME LEMONADE

Serves 8 Hands-On Time 20 min

1 cup sugar 8 sprigs fresh thyme, plus more for serving

1 quart strawberries, hulled and sliced (about 2 1/2 cups)

1 1/2 cups fresh lemon juice (from about 10 lemons)

Combine the sugar, thyme, and 1 cup water in a small pot. Bring to a boil and cook, stirring occasionally, until the sugar is dissolved. Let cool and discard the thyme.

Combine the thyme syrup with the strawberries, lemon juice, and 5 cups cold water in a large pitcher. Chill for 30 minutes or up to 12 hours. Serve over ice, garnished with additional thyme. Add a splash of vodka, if desired.

Above is the original recipe. I used 1/2 cup sugar to make the thyme syrup, juice of 2 lemons, 3 cups ice into a pitcher with the sliced strawberries and then filled the pitcher with ready made lemonade. Really tasty and easy!

BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS

The sanctuary/Westminster roof project is not finished. The gutters need to be installed. Central Roofing will be contacted to find out when the job will be done.

Tromborg Royal Plumbing removed the old water heater and installed a new one. The cost was \$1,400.

There is a new garbage system in Tweedie Hall. There are containers for garbage, recycle and compost. Compost includes food scraps, dirty paper plates, and dirty paper cups. Recycle includes cans, bottles, clean paper, aluminum, and recyclable plastics. Garbage includes plastic straws, and all Styrofoam. Please check the signs above the containers for more information.
