We made a review of donations made in the past few years. We decided to continue with a Sock It To Me Sunday in August with the socks going to Puente in Pescadero. We will invite a speaker for Sunday, September 30.

Six hundred dollars have been set aside for the food bags which will be prepared in November for Northern Peninsula Food Pantry and Dining Center of Daly City. We spent two hundred twenty five dollars to purchase gift cards, 10-\$20 Lucky cards and 5-\$5 McDonald cards for the use of the pastor when someone comes to the door of the office seeking help.
