It is just a limitation, a uniqueness, that enables a person to make a vitally important and distinctive contribution to life and the Christian community." 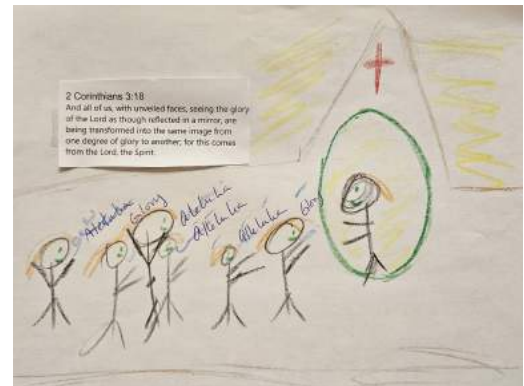

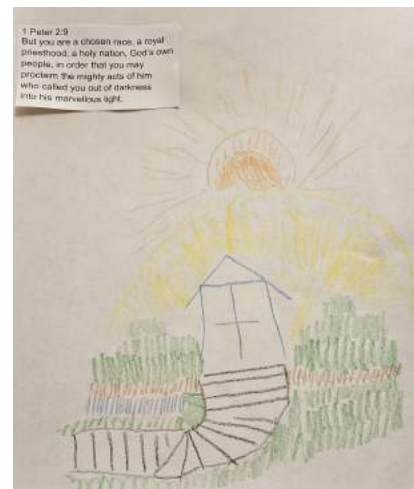
The Elder Retreat was held on Saturday, April 13, 2024. One of the three activities done was to draw our interpretation of a scripture...



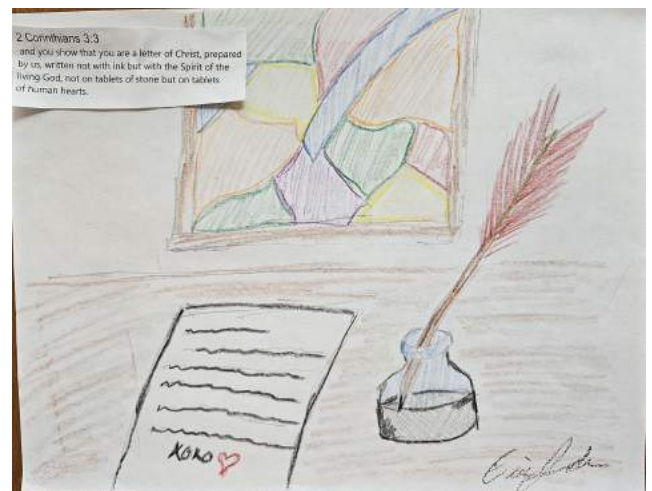

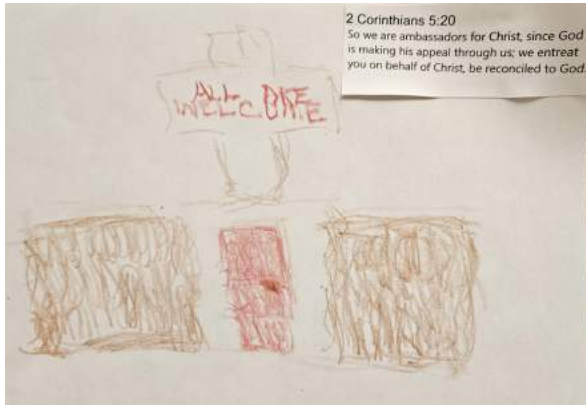

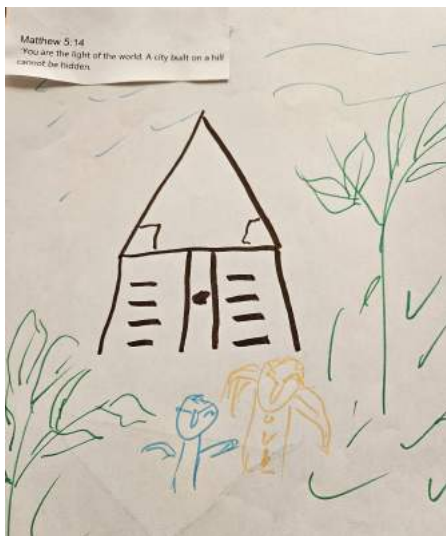
